A) INTRODUCTION

The youth of the country is a national asset and its development is a task of great significance and importance. The NCC has got expertise and built-in-infrastructure to fulfil this goal on behalf of the Nation. Over the years NCC has contributed towards the goal in an effective and meaningful manner. Also, the NCC is the largest youth org in the world with an approx strength of 15 lacs cadets. As a Cadet of the NCC, it is very important to understand the basic organisation of the Indian Army at a macro level. A look at the command and control structure shows how finely it has been tuned to meet India's threat perception based on the major wars that it has fought and the present day geo-political scenario.

The Headquarter of National Cadet Corps is at New Delhi, India. NCC is open to school and college students on voluntary basis. National Cadet Corps is a Tri-services Organization, comprising the Army, Navy and Air Force, engaged in grooming the youth of country into disciplined and patriotic citizen. The National Cadet Corps in India is a voluntary organization which recruits cadets from high school, colleges and universities all over in India.

I) Historical Background of National Cadet Corps

During First World War, Britisher's created the *University Corps* with an aim for second line of defence and also to have a large pool of trained youth available for employment into the Armed Forces. NCC in India was conceptualised and raised before Independence, mainly with an aim to groom the youth, boys and girls both, nurture them and channelize their energy towards nation building by making them responsible citizen. After independence, the present day NCC came into existence on 16 Apr 1948, through *XXXI Act of Parliament*. NCC was formally inaugurated on *15 Jul 1948*.

The Girls Division of the NCC was raised in *Jul 1949*. On 01 Apr 1950, Air Wing was raised, with one Air squadron each at Bombay and Kolkata. The Naval Wing of the NCC was raised in *Jul 1952*, thus completing the true representation of all services in the Corps. Today the NCC has an enrolled strength of more than 15 Lakhs cadets and it basically comprises of two divisions of all the three Services ie, the Senior Division (SD) boys/ Senior Wing (SW) for girls from colleges and the Junior Division (JD) for boys, Junior Wing (JW) girls from schools. The present day NCC came into existence on 16 Apr 1948, through XXXI Act of Parliament. NCC was formally inaugurated on 15 Jul 1948, as soon as the schools and colleges reopened after summer vacation.

II) Motto of NCC

The motto of NCC is '*Unity & Discipline*' which was adopted on 23 Dec 1957. In living up to its motto, the NCC strives to be and is one of the greatest cohesive forces of the nation, bringing together the youth hailing from different parts of the country and moulding them into united, secular and disciplined citizens of the nation.

III) Aim of NCC

- i. To Develop Character, Comradeship, Discipline, Leadership, Secular Outlook, Spirit of Adventure, and Ideals of Selfless Service amongst the Youth of the Country.
- ii. To create a human resource of Organised, Trained and Motivated youth, to provide leadership in all walks of life and always be available for the service of the nation.
- iii. To provide a suitable environment to motivate the youth to take up a career in the Armed Forces.

IV) CORE VALUES

The NCC is a responsive, learning and continuously evolving organization. Its activity is guided by certain core values that we endeavor to instill among all ranks of the NCC.

These include the following:

1. A sense of patriotic commitment to encourage cadets to contribute to national development.
2. Respect for diversities in religion, language, culture, ethnicity, life style and habitat to instill a sense of National unity and social cohesion.
3. Abiding commitment to learn and adhere to the norms and values enshrined in the Indian Constitution.
4. Understanding the value of a just and impartial exercise of authority.
5. Ability to participate in community development and other social programme.
6. A healthy life style free of substance abuse and other unhealthy practices.
7. Sensitivity to the needs of poor and socially disadvantaged fellow citizens.
8. Inculcating habits of restraint and self-awareness.
9. Understanding the values of honesty, truthfulness, self-sacrifice, perseverance and hard work.
10. Respect for knowledge, wisdom and the power of ideas.

VI) NCC Flag

In 1954 the existing tricolor flag was introduced. The three colours in the flag depict the three services in the Corps, red for Army, deep blue for Navy and light blue for the Air Force. The letters NCC and the NCC Crest in gold in the middle of the flag enriched by a wreath of lotus, give the flag a colourful look and a distinct identity. Each lotus represents one NCC Directorate (Dte). The two dots represent Officer Training Academy's in India they are at *Gwalior*, Madhya Pradesh and *Kamptee*, Nagpur Maharashtra.

VII) NCC Song

An Official Song of the NCC titled "Kadam Mila Ke Chal" was adopted in 1963. This was, however, changed to the current NCC Song titled "***Ham Sabh Bhartiya Hain***" in Oct 1982. The song written by Shri Chiranjit was approved, in 1976. '***Ham Sabh Bhartiya Hain***' - NCC song is written by *Sudarshan Fakir*.

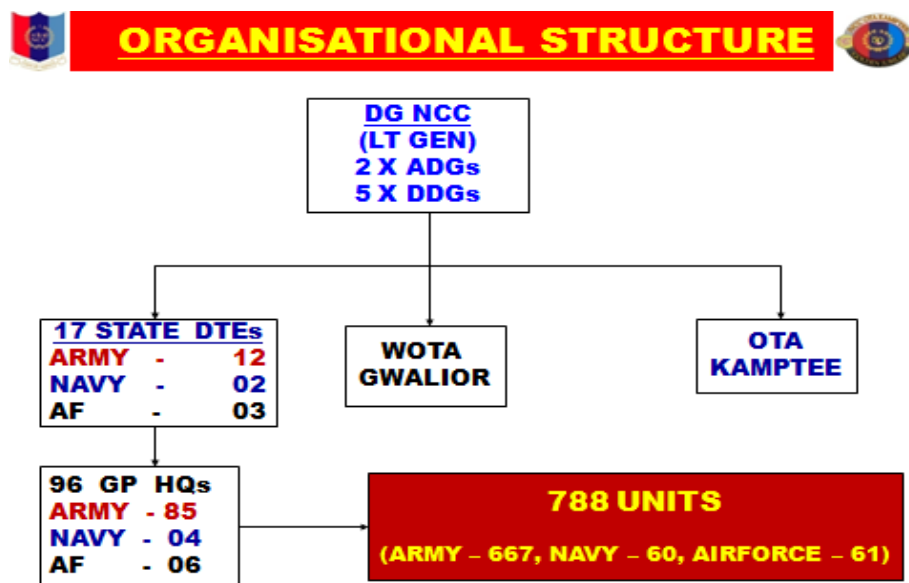

VIII) NCC Organization



The NCC is a voluntary organization which is administered through the Ministry of Defence. The Defence Secretary is overall in charge, which is responsible to the Govt of India for efficient functioning of the NCC and other matters. At the Headquarters level, this organization is headed by an officer of the rank of Lieutenant General who is responsible for the functioning of the NCC in the country. There are 17 Directorates located in the state capitals headed by an officer of the rank of a Major General / Brigadier or equivalent from the three Services.

Depending upon the size of the state and growth of NCC in the states, Directorates have up to 14 Group Headquarters under them through which they exercise their command and control of the organisation in the state. Each group is headed by an officer of the rank of Brig / Colonel or equivalent known as Group Commander. Each NCC Group Headquarters controls 5-7 NCC units / battalions, commanded by Colonel / Lieutenant Colonel or equivalent.

Each battalion consists of companies which are commanded by the Associate NCC Officers (ANO) of the rank of Lieutenant, Captain or Major. In all, there are 95 Group Headquarters in the country who exercise control over a network of 667 Army Wing Units (including technical and girls unit), 60 Naval Wing Units and 61 Air Squadrons. There are two training establishments namely Officers Training School, Kamptee and Women Officers Training School, Gwalior where professors and teachers from colleges and schools are specially trained to impart training to the cadets as Associate NCC Officers (ANOs).

NCC Training: Two types of training

1. Institutional Training
2. Camp Training

A. Institutional Training

Institutional Training conducted at Colleges and Schools is the mainstay of NCC training and is conducted by Associated NCC Officers and Armed Forces Personnel. Institutional training includes basic military training to the cadets as part of the curriculum and prepares them to join the Armed Forces. It is conducted with the following specific purpose.

- Firstly, young cadets to a regimental way of life, which is essential to inculcate in them the values of discipline, duty, punctuality, orderliness, smartness, respect, for the authorities, correct work ethos, and self- confidence.
- Secondly, to generate interest in cadets by including and laying emphasis on those aspects of institutional training which attract young cadets into the NCC and provides them an element of thrill and excitement.
- Thirdly, to inculcate Defence Services work ethos that is characterised by hard work, sincerely, selfless service etc



B. Camp Training

Camp Training is the practical manifestation of institutional training. The basic aim of camp is to introduce cadets to excitement of camp life where they apply the theoretical knowledge that they had gained in institutional training. 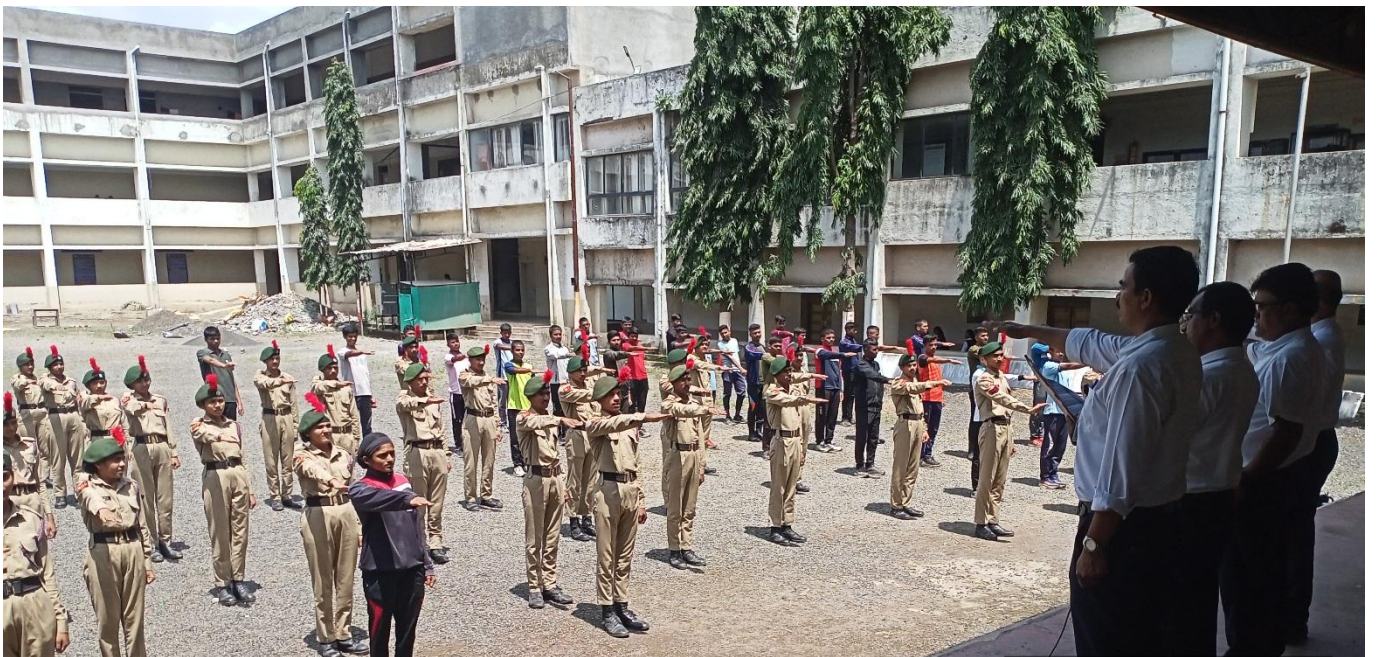


