About Institution:

Maratha Vidya Prasarak Samaj, Nashik was established by Karmaveer Raosaheb Thorat, Karmaveer Ganpatdada More, Karmaveer D.R. Bhosale and their supporters, keeping in view the aim of impairing education to the masses. Inspired by the teachings and guidance of Mahatma Jyotiba Phule, Rajarshi Shahu Maharaj, Shrimant Sayajirao Gaikwad Maharaj, Maharshi Vitthal Ramji Shinde, Karmaveer Bhaurao Patil and the like. Objectives of the Nature Club

- > To introduce the students to the conservation of environment and natural resources.
- > To generate awareness about Nature that has direct bearing upon our physical and mental human health.

- > To give the students a feel of natural life by arranging awareness programmes like Bird watching, Trekking and Nature Camp under the NSS camp.
- To arrange meetings, workshops, talks and field trips and picnics for students to create and enhance their awareness of natural environment, biological diversity and naturopathy.
- > To achieve the goal of green and clean campus.
- ➤ To promote concepts of wildlife friendly eco- tourism, eco-friendly house and alternate and reusable energy sources among students.

Activities Run by Nature Club

- 1. Under the Nature club students and teachers of the Botany department every year plants multiple number of trees in the College campus and looks after their maintenance including irrigation, weeding, fertigation etc.
- 2. Department of Botany under nature club established various special *vanas* in the College campus which includes, *Rashi van* (different plants have been planted on the basis of 12 Zodiac signs), *Nakshatra van* (Various plants planted on the basis of total stars), *Saraswati van* (The plants which activate brain of the person), and *Vrindavan* (Different types of tulsi species have been planted). These vanas are planted in the garden as per the special maps. This plantation also has scientific base. This activity is important to develop sacred grooves in the College campus.
- 3. Staff members of Botany under Nature club planted many plants out of the campus. For example we had planted many plants on the road side of Manegaon road. Also, we planted trees at Dubere village during the NSS special camp.
- 4. Our staff members under Nature club guide villagers, students and other people of society about the plantation and inculcate awareness among them about plant conservation.
- 5. We also look after the rainwater harvesting, green and environmental audit of the College, cleaning campaigns, maintenance of ecosystem ponds, reduce plastic pollution in the College campus and associated activities.
- 6. Members of the department always actively involved in the various awareness programmes, rallies organized by various supportive services of the college. During such

- programmes we used to make students aware about overconsumption of fossil fuels, causes of environmental pollution, ecosystem disturbances and so on.
- 7. We under '*Nature club*' always try to underline the role of plants in the life of human. We sown such seeds in the minds of students to percolate this awareness in the society deeply.
- 8. Under Nature club, Department of Botany too an initiative to develop an artificial pond in the College campus which are made up from waste tyres of vehicles. This gives a message of 'Sustaining from discarded'. In these artificial ponds we tried our best to cultivate Azolla and water lily. This practice is highly beneficial to enhance the beauty of the College campus.
- 9. In future also we will try our best to do something new for the conservation of plants and nature under the Nature club.
- 10. Under Nature club we are actively involved in the Seed ball formation activity by NCC students and also guided them preparing viable seed balls.
- 11. Under Nature club, we continuously engaged in the maintenance and enrichment of botanical garden by planting various medicinal and wild plants.
