Feedback System

The academic year 2021-22 IQAC has developed a system of feedback through online mode. The four types of online Google feedback forms were created for the students, teachers, alumni and parents. Responses were collected, analyzed and action was taken for the cautionary measures for better educational improvement.

Following is the summary of the feedback system followed at G.M.D. Arts, B.W. Commerce and Science College Sinnar, Dist. Nashik, Maharashtra, during the academic year 2021-22

a) Student Feedback

Feedback was collected from the students on teaching faculty and the curriculum. For this, 11 questions were provided to the students to evaluate the teachers and syllabus by 5 scale evaluation including excellent, very good, good, poor and unsatisfactory.

b) Teacher Feedback

Google form for the teacher was created and sent to the teachers via whats app and email to note their impressions on syllabus, college campus, college administration and facilities provided by the college library.

c) Alumni Feedback



Issues raised by the Students
