The students of T.Y.B.sc. Zoology and M.Sc. Zoology visited at Kokan, to visit Amision Fisheries Institute, Marine Water Ecosystem, Tarkarli Beach, Sindhudurga Fort and Ganpatu Pule during 13th Feb 2020 to 16th Feb 2020 as per following programme.
